
Fixation: the white dots (fixation dots) should be in the same location (center of the pupil or slightly nasal) in both eyes; pupils should be a consistent color (red or dark brown) with no white tones.



Fixation Problem:

The child is looking up a little.

The white fixation dot is not in same place in each eye, and the pupil is not consistent in color.
